Camp Coordination Work

Workshop/Curriculum Development

Help us structure each workshop according to a set of guidelines and tailor the workshops for each week's camp. We want to have the curriculum, materials and talking points clearly laid out for each workshop so that almost anybody could jump in and run the workshop as needed. This task requires great organizational skills and lots of creative thinking! We'll probably have at least two committee meetings in June and July to finalize the workshops.

Create rockin' camp guide for campers w/ articles, resources, etc.

This is a large project, probably too big for this year. We'd love a small informative zine, however, with the workshop descriptions, schedules, basic music theory/gear info, etc.

Lunch-time performance coordination

Volunteer coordinators will be running this job, but we're sure they could use your help!

Coordinate food donations for volunteers

We could use help soliciting food/drink donations for volunteers working at the camps. This could mean reaching out to parents, local restaurants and caterers, or your friend who makes a bangin' pasta salad. Get creative! All sustenance is appreciated!

Gather materials for workshops/campers

Work with the workshop development team on listing and obtaining items needed for each workshop. Soliciting donations would be great, but we also have a budget for this.

Volunteer at Camp

Teach a workshop

Using the workshop curriculum guide, work with the directors to teach a workshop. The volunteer coordinators will also work with you to make sure you have enough folks to help you teach!

Manage a band (must be able to be present for at least 2hrs every day)

Help the girls form a band, decide what they'll be playing and facilitate song-writing. There's also quite a bit of guidance (without directing) and mediating that happens here. The girls really rely on you to help them through this challenging process, from giving more hi-fives than you thought physically possible to helping them find the right amp sound or navigate two drummers on one set. This task takes patience, flexibility and a ton of enthusiasm! This is an all-week position. We're working on a very modest stipend for band managers, TBA.

Provide extra support to teachers

Just be here for us! Be available as an extra set of hands for the workshops, a chaperone for bathroom trips and one more smiling face for the girls. This is perfect for volunteers that want to be involved, but don't have the time/energy to lead a workshop or be at camp consistently. We welcome all levels of involvement, and this is a great opportunity for busy ladies!

Make the camp zine for each location

We'll need someone to compile the zine workshop entries for each camp into a zine for the girls. We'd love to find someone to donate printing/paper/etc. We can also pay you to go to Kinkos and copy like you've never copied before if need be.

Volunteer at Cat's Cradle Showcase

This is the payoff, people. We need lots of help for this one, but this is the most fun so you'll definitely want to be here. Here are a few of the tasks broken out:

-Project-manage the event. Coordinate band playing times, speakers, etc. so that 16 bands can get on stage and perform within 2.5 hours. We did it with 18 last year! We're sure Lindsay

Thomas and Katy Barron, last year's coordinators, would be willing to share their schedule/script with you. It was a masterpiece! We need another one!

-Roadie. Be on call next to the stage during the performance to tune instruments, hand them to girls, hand the girls pics and drumsticks, and generally troubleshoot all equipment issues/needs during the performance.

-Girl shuffler. Help the girls get where they need to be, get fed, and get fabulous with stylists pre-show.

-Set-up crew. Hang posters, set up the merch table, get stage set, etc.

-Break down crew. The exact opposite of set up crew. We really appreciate the extra help at the end of a long night!

-Merch table/networker. Sell t-shirts, merch, etc. and talk to folks about the organization while you're doing it!
